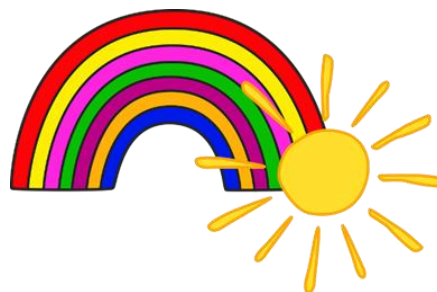
Covid Measures
