The club is not exclusively for key workers and will be open to everyone, as we know that many schools are not providing holiday clubs this year due to COVID-19.

The children will use the preschool room, that the Alligator bubble have been using so- they will have their own classroom space equipped with lots of fun, age appropriate resources. We have lots of great activities and local outings planned for the children so it should be fantastic. We are looking forward to the new challenge and are confident we can create a fun learning environment that the children will want to be part of.
