Eco-School Award



Yeah... We finally recieved our Eco-School Green Flag award. We completed the accreditation last month and have been waiting for our certificate and flag to arrive. We really are pleased with this achievement as we have made many changes in nursery to make us more eco-friendly.

Over the last two years, we have reduced our plastic usage by cutting out some of our single-use plastics- for example, we now have our milk delivered in glass bottles not plastic cartons. We have kept the local community clear by litter picking, tidying and reporting any issues to the council. We had automatic switch off taps fitted in the bathrooms- so we don't use more water than needed. We created a big bug hotel to promote insect bio- diversity not to mention our textile collections that we have done to help reduce waste going to landfill. We are super proud of our efforts, and of the children who have helped us along the way. Obviously, we plan to continue working towards being as energy efficient and eco friendly as we can be. We welcome any suggestions.

COVID-19 Update

The nursery received lateral flow tests for the staff last week. We will start rolling these out on 22nd March. The tests are there to help identify people that are asymptomatic and don't realise they have COVID-19. We know we have a few parents that are now using lateral flow tests regularly too, so we're hopeful that infection rates in nursery will continue to stay as low as they are.
