Thank you to everyone that completed our parent questionnaire a few weeks back. We had a great response- twice as many people completed the electronic version this year than the paper version last year. 30 Hour funding

If your child is due to turn 3 before the end of August this year, then you may be entitled to extra funding. Your eligibility depends on:

- if you are working
- your income (and your partner's income if you have one)
- your child's age and circumstances
- your immigration status
