COVID-19 Update

Last week we had two confirmed COVID cases in our preschool room. These were children and not staff. It's clear the virus is very much still prevalent around Telford and Wrekin with numbers being high again, so we know it is still a worry for many. Nursery has updated their policies to co-inside with the government guidelines. These can be found using this link: <http://telfordnurseries.org/files/policies/COVID%20RA.pdf>

The main points to remember though are:

- If your child has one of the three main symptoms: continuous cough, high temperature or loss of taste then they must take a PCR test. If negative children can return straight away. If positive, then we ask that children remain at home for the required isolation period to ensure the virus is not spread around the nursery setting.
- Children can still come into nursery if a family member at home has COVID, however they will be sent home immediately for a PCR test if they display any of the 3 main symptoms.
- Children who are absent from nursery because they have COVID themselves will still be charged as normal as the illness period will be treated normally as per our sickness policy.

If you have any concerns or worries, then please do contact the nursery. We are hopeful that things are starting to return to normal but appreciate it is still uncertain times and things are always likely to change.
