Winter clothing

Just a reminder to parents to bring in extra clothes to nursery for their children please. We are finding that children do not have enough spare clothes in nursery and warm garments for outdoor play. Ideally children need hats, gloves, warm waterproof coats, and wellies for this time of year. Children will have access to outdoors at least once during each day, regardless of the weather so it's important they stay warm and dry if they are to be happy. Please also help us by labelling these items to help us locate them when we need to.

We had a brilliant Forest school session last week. Lighting the fire was a great learning opportunity for the children. They listened and abided by the safety rules beautifully and enjoyed their homemade S'mores and warm squash.
